
### Optional Land Extensions

### Available Cabins


#### Suites



Cruise Day 1	Port of Dijon	<i>Embarkation</i>

		Only doing the cruise? Today you will arrive in Dijon, France. Embark the ship in Dijon for your <i>Flavors of Burgundy</i> wine cruise with Nice Winery!
Cruise Day 2	Port of Dijon  to Seurre	<i>Seurre</i>  <i>Excursion and guided tour of Dijon</i> <i>OR a guided bike tour along the Saône River</i> <i>OR visit the stunning Château d'Arcelot</i>
		Famously known as the "Birthplace of Mustard," Dijon was the home to the four Dukes of Burgundy from 1364 to 1477. On a guided tour, explore Dijon's medieval center, which overflows with art and cultural heritage, showcased within several spectacular museums. Alternatively, embark on a guided bike tour along the Saône River and witness captivating sites such as the lock controlling the river's access to the Rhône-Rhine Canal. Or choose to visit the stunning Château d'Arcelot, with elements dating back to the 13th century. The Château d'Arcelot blends medieval religious structures, neoclassical architecture, and even a Chinese pavilion into a fascinating architectural marvel. Transfer to Seurre and enjoy a free evening.
Cruise Day 3	Chalon-Sur-Saône	<i>Beaune walking tour</i> <i>OR Chalon-Sur-Saône Scenic Tour</i> <i>OR Chalon-Sur-Saône Bike Tour</i> <i>OR Clos de Vougeot Wine Tasting Tour</i>
		Visit the town of Beaune, a walled town nestled in the heart of Cote d'Or vineyards where you'll stroll the cobblestone streets and take in such sights as the mosaic-tiled roof of the Hospices de Beaune, founded in the 15th century as a hospital for the less fortunate. In the afternoon, enjoy a scenic sailing by the picturesque city of Chalon-Sur-Saône or opt for a more active outing with a bike tour. Alternatively, visit Clos de Vougeot, a wall-enclosed vineyard with over 900 years of wine-making history and savor the flavors of the regional wines.
Cruise Day 4	Chalon-Sur-Saône  to Tournus	<i>Chalon-Sur-Saône Historic City Tour</i> <i>OR Château de Couches Tour</i> <i>OR Tournus Wine Tour</i> <i>OR Chalon-Sur-Saône to Tournus Bike Tour</i>
		Located in southern Burgundy at the heart of the Côte Chalonnaise wine region, Chalon-sur-Saône whispers the secrets of its medieval past which you will discover on your historic city tour. Or visit the storybook Château de Couches, a medieval fortress enveloped in idyllic hills and greenery that once served the Dukes of Burgundy. Later in the day, enjoy a scenic sailing to Tournus, or learn about centuries old traditions while sampling the region's famous Chalonnaise wines. Alternatively, pedal from Chalon-sur-Saône to Tournus on an exhilarating guided bike tour.
Cruise Day 5	Tournus  To Mâcon	<i>Tournus City Tour</i> <i>OR Château de Cormatin Tour</i> <i>OR Village of Brancion Tour</i> <i>OR Guided Bike Tour from Tournus to Mâcon</i> <i>OR Wine Tasting tour in Mâcon</i>

		Today you have a choice of a number of excursions as you explore the cities of Tournus and Mâcon. Let your knowledgeable guide lead you through Tournus and to its magnificent Benedictine Abbey of Saint Philibert. Or choose instead to visit the moated Château de Cormatin, which dates back to the early 17th century and features ornate apartments as well as a beautifully manicured garden. As an alternative, venture to the medieval village of Brancion with its preserved gateway, church and market hall. Return to the ship and enjoy a scenic cruise to Mâcon. Or, instead, join a guided bike tour from Tournus to Mâcon or go wine tasting and meet the ship in Mâcon.
Cruise Day 6	Mâcon	<i>Guided Tour of Mâcon</i>
		Join a guided tour through the “South Burgundy City” of Mâcon, learning about its local vineyards, museums, historical sites and perhaps its famous son, the poet and minister Alphonse de Lamartine. Or venture somewhat off the beaten path to Cluny, known for its large abbey. Built between the 4th and 12th centuries, Cluny Abbey was formerly the world’s largest church and stands as a captivating example of early Romanesque architecture.
Cruise Day 7	Viviers To Arles	<i>Viviers Bike Tour OR Grignan Hilltop Village Tour OR Truffle Farm Tour OR Viviers Scenic Walk</i>
		Take your coffee on your balcony or the Sun Deck as you cruise to Viviers, a charming medieval city with picturesque 16th and 18th century monuments. For a more active adventure, pedal through this bicycle-friendly city. Alternately, you can go to the magnificent hilltop village, Grignan. After visiting this enchanting Provençal town, go in search of the highly prized “Black Diamond” truffles with a farmer and his trustworthy canine companion. Or, go on a scenic hike and enjoy a memorable view of Viviers.
Day 8	Arles	<i>Disembarkation</i>
		Bid farewell to Arles and prepare for your return flight home.
